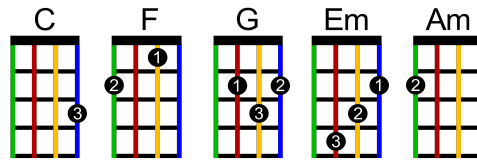


Frosty the Snowman
